### Fascinating Fact



Many people are familiar with the true story of the Mutiny on the Bounty on April 28, 1789. It is a story of a frustrated ship's crew rising up against their captain, William Bligh, under the leadership of Lieutenant Fletcher Christian. The crew eventually settled on the islands of Tahiti or Pitcairn. Fletcher and a group of 27 others including 8 crewmen, 12 Tahitian women (some of whom were married to the sailors), 6 Polynesian men and a baby arrived at Pitcairn and began to settle the uninhabited island. Over the next few years all of the sailors, including Christian, died except for John Adams. Disease and skirmishes with other Polynesian groups caused their deaths. However numerous children were born and those descendants continued to live and became Christians under the leadership of Adams who had turned to God because of the trials and violence he had experienced. In 1887 an Adventist missionary, John Tay, arrived at Pitcairn and began to teach the Bible to all of the people on Pitcairn. Every single person accepted the Bible teachings and became Seventh-day Adventists. Today Pitcairn has 54 residents, mostly descendants of the Bounty sailors. Of those 54 people 37 now attend the Adventist church.
